A new sports cage has opened on the site of the old tennis courts in Victoria Park.

Almost £90,000 was secured by the Friends of Victoria Park with grants from Barclay's Spaces for Sport, the Tameside Trust, Tameside Sports Development Fund, and the District Assembly.
