Denton's **Victoria Park** has just won its **eighth consecutive Green Flag Award**. Over the past year, a **new children's play area** has been installed, the historic grade II listed **bandstand has been restored** and **new floral features** have been introduced.



## Oldhams' Update...

Councillors recently met with developers Langtree Group to raise their concerns about the former Oldhams Batteries site, which is the missing piece of the town centre regeneration jigsaw.

Despite having been granted outline planning permission earlier in the year, the development has ground to a halt while **a compulsory purchase order is sought** on a piece of land being held by a rival developer. The land in question, off Ashton Road, effectively prevents the construction of the new link road with Hyde Road.

Meanwhile, **detailed plans are set to be submitted to the Council imminently**, which will set out the design of the proposed buildings and landscaping.

Until Langtree is able to commence the development, they have **promised to strengthen the security on the site with new fencing** and the demolition of derelict buildings along Hyde Road.
